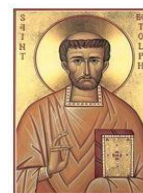

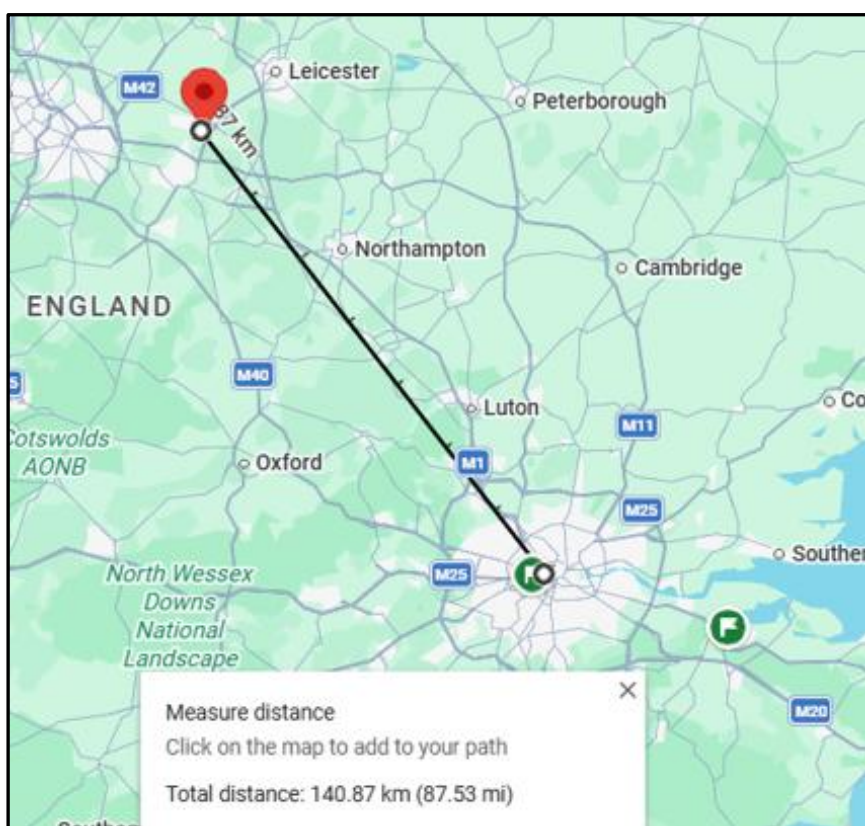

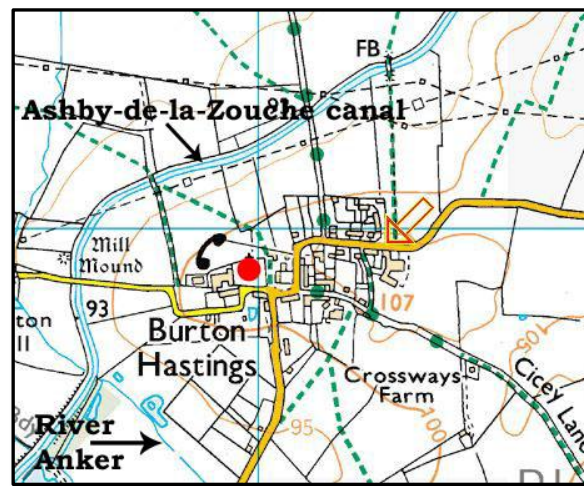

THE 19th September 2026 HERITAGE OPEN DAY

- Take part in a treasure hunt to discover some of the older features of the church.
- See the additions to this peaceful old church which bring it into the 21st Century. There will be a slide show of pictures of village life including some characters who lived there all their lives.
- In addition to a special art exhibition showing works by local artists, there will be a demonstration of stained glass making presented by an artist who lives in the village.
- Take a guided stroll along a section of a pilgrimage route depicted in the church's Millennium Window, including one of three listed bridges around the village.
- Tea and coffee will be available. Car parking is available by the church. There are no steps between the road and the inside of the building.
